

How do I...

Change the phone number or other information for ZTerm ...


Change the phone number for a particular carrier

Launch your ZTerm program. If you have been using it regularly, just launch it the same way you normally would to submit claims.

Go up under DIAL and select Directory.

Double-click on the provider whose number you want to change.

You will get a window with the provider name at the top. Just enter the new phone number, change Data Rate (if necessary, if you are not sure *do not* change it), and click OK. That's it, you're done.

Change the login and/or password

You will need to go into the logon script(s) for that particular provider. The file will end in .zts and it will be located in either the ZTerm application program (before OS X) or in the users folder (in OS X). It may be located in both places and if it is you will need to make sure you change it in both places.

Follows is a sample script. The one for your provider may be longer or otherwise different.

# MCS.zts dial in script	<- lines that begin with a # are for your information
wait prompt "Please Login:"	<- tells the program to wait for a login prompt
send "login^M"	<- put your login^M within quotes after send
wait prompt "Password?"	<- tells the program to wait for a password prompt
send "password^M"	<- put your password^M within quotes after send

Your old password and/or login will be in the original script which should make it easier to know what and where to replace.
